



GMAP Region 2 Trainee/Early Stage Investigator Travel Scholarship Fact Sheet

Purpose: The Trainee/ Early Stage Investigator (ESI) Scholarship is intended to support underrepresented scholars and investigators in career development related to cancer research or cancer health disparities research by providing reimbursement (i.e. registration, airfare, hotel, etc.) for scholars to:

- Present research at conferences
- Attend Workshops/Trainings

Scholar Eligibility

- Trainee/ESI must be located in a GMAP Region 2 state/territory (AL, AR, FL, GA, LA, MS, MO, PR)
- Must be one of the following:
 - **Trainee:** Must be at minimum a PhD candidate or post-doctoral fellow. Must provide proof of enrollment and letter of recommendation from mentor or department chair.
 - **Early Stage Investigator (ESI):** Individual is within 10 years of completing terminal degree (PhD/DrPH/MD) and has not yet been awarded a substantial, competing NIH research grant.

Application Deadline

- Complete application package must be received at least four weeks prior to travel date.

Application Guidelines

- **Pre-Approval**
 - The maximum available per person is \$2,000. Priority will be given to those who have not received a GMAP Region 2 travel award in the past. Awards will be granted until funds are used for each funding period.
 - This is a competitive award. Travel Scholarship application must be submitted for approval **prior** to attending conference/workshop. A committee will approve awards based on merit.
 - Scholarships will be awarded to reimburse for meeting expenses; funds cannot be provided in advance.
 - Meetings must be in the United States or Puerto Rico.
 - If awarded, must agree to include the following statement on presentations: "Travel was made possible in part by grant 3P30CA076292-21S4 (Geographic Management of Cancer Health Disparities Program (GMAP) Region 2) funded by the National Cancer Institute"
 - Priority given to individuals presenting work relating to cancer research & cancer health disparities or attending a skills session
- **Post Approval**
 - All reimbursement requests (e.g. receipts) must be received by Moffitt Cancer Center within **three weeks** of travel completion (last day of the conference) for reimbursement.
 - Original itemized receipts are required. A reimbursement form and instructions to mail receipts will be provided.
 - Awardees will be required to complete a short Post Award Report that describes how the conference helped your career objectives and research, and what professional connections you made. The format and other information will be sent to scholarship recipients.

SCHOLAR ELIGIBILITY

Trainee/ESI must be located in a GMaP Region 2 state/territory (AL, AR, FL, GA, LA, MS, MO, PR)

Must be one of the following:

Trainee/Jr. Faculty: Must be at minimum a PhD candidate, post-doctoral fellow or early junior faculty. Must provide proof of enrollment and a brief letter of recommendation and support (no more than half a page) from mentor or department chair confirming potential benefit of conference attendance or training to applicant.

Early Stage Investigator (ESI): individual is within 10 years of completing terminal research degree/medical residency (or equivalent) and has not yet been awarded a substantial, competing NIH research grant.

This award may be used as a supplement to other scholarships, but may not be used to duplicate other resources.
